It is a basic requirement of nomination for any office in the Union that candidates be financial on the date nominations open. Intending candidates should consult the Union's rules for other eligibility requirements.

By email: A properly completed nomination form including all necessary signatures and attachments may be scanned and submitted as a pdf file to nswelections@aec.gov.au. **Note:** Emails larger than 6MB in size may not be accepted by the AEC's firewall. Senders of emails to the AEC email mailbox should be aware that incoming emails that appear to be spam emails may be blocked. It is the responsibility of the sender to ensure their email reaches the AEC email mailbox before the deadline.

The ballot, if required, will open on 22 August 2016 and close at 5pm AEST on Monday, 12 September 2016.

For Tram and Bus Division only, attendance ballots will be held on Thursday, 8 September 2016 between 7:00am and 4:30pm AEST at the relevant bus depots
