

LAUNCH OF MACQUARIE UNIVERSITY WORKERS COMPENSATION CUTS REPORT

In June 2012, The NSW Liberal Government introduced some of the cruellest cuts to workers compensation ever seen in this country.

The cuts included: Cuts to medical expenses that support you rehabilitating and returning to work after injury. Cuts to weekly payments so injured workers have to pay more for getting injured at work Cuts to legal expenses and access to legal support so that more injured workers are forced to take on the insurance companies alone. Cuts to journey claims, heart attack and stroke claims, and making it difficult for all but the catastrophically injured to access long term workers compensation.

Macquarie University have been commissioned to undertake independent research into the cuts over three years and will be discussing the findings of their research at:
