**ORDERS**

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
A. Pursuant to s. 136(1)(c) and s. 137(1)(a) of the *Industrial Relations Act 1996*, the Commission makes the following orders:

1. The Rail, Tram and Bus Union of New South Wales ("RTBU") must direct its members employed by the Transport Secretary under s. 68C(1)(b) of the *Transport Administration Act 1988* not to engage in any form of industrial action, including any strike, stop work meeting, ban, relieving ban, limitation or restriction on the performance of work, refusal to wear uniforms, any form of fare discounting or action which results in reduced or nil fare collection, including by causing written notices to be posted on the BusExpress website, [busexpress.com.au](http://busexpress.com.au), by 6pm on 31 May 2017.
2. These orders shall come into effect immediately.

B. Pursuant to s. 136(1) of the *Industrial Relations Act*, the Commission makes the following directions:

1. The RTBU must, by no later than 6pm on 31 May 2017, provide or cause to be provided a copy of these orders to its delegates employed by the Transport Secretary under s. 68C(1)(b) of the *Transport Administration Act 1988*.

2. The RTBU must advise the Notifier's legal representatives in writing by 22:00 on 31 May 2017 of the steps taken to comply with these Orders, including the form of notification and, if written, a copy of the notification and the further steps they intend to take (if any) to comply with these Orders in respect of any employee who, by that time, has not been notified.
