The other matters that were discussed at the meeting.

- Keeping employees at one fixed location each day.
- Seeking employee consent to voluntary reduce their leave were possible.
- Providing the necessary safety equipment and protection.
- Should you become subject to an Infection and need to be self-Isolated this will be dealt on case by case situation (if this is necessary, you will be supported by the Union).
- Seeking employees to assist in keeping the workplace free from any potential risks by wiping down the hard surfaces that the community may touch.

It is important in these times that both Unions, members, and management work together to get the best outcome, not only for members but the community and support each other through this.
